Sub: Commission decision on the appeal submitted by the HEI under Regulation 6 of Part II of University Grants Commission (Open and Distance Learning Programmes and Online Programmes) Regulations, 2020 for offering programmes in Online mode from academic year 2023-24, session beginning July, 2023 and onwards - regarding

Sir/Madam,

This is in continuation to the Commission Order of even number dated 20<sup>th</sup> March, 2024 wherein the recommendations of the Expert Review Committee were communicated to **Jagannath University, Rajasthan.**

2. As per the provisions under Regulation 6 of the University Grants Commission (Open and Distance Learning Programmes and Online Programmes) Regulations, 2020, the Higher Educational Institution was provided an opportunity to submit an appeal along with requisite fee and documentary evidence for the programme(s) not recognized as per the UGC letter cited in above para, if any, within 30 days from the date of the communication of assessment sheet of the Expert Review Committee (as communicated in the said UGC letter).

3. The appeal along with documents submitted by the **Jagannath University, Rajasthan** have been placed before duly constituted Standing Appellate Committee in the virtual meeting held on **17.10.2023**. The Standing Appellate Committee based on the appeal submitted along with documentary evidences, interaction with HEIs representatives and the provisions of the University Grants Commission (Open and Distance Learning Programmes and Online Programmes) Regulations, 2020 and its amendments; made recommendations for consideration of the Competent Authority/Commission.

4. Based on the recommendations of Standing Appellate Committee and its approval by Competent Authority/Commission, I am directed to issue this Order, thereby communicating the decision, on the appeal submitted by HEI for offering programme(s) in **Online mode** from academic year 2023-24 session beginning July-August, 2023 and onwards, by **Jagannath University, Rajasthan** as detailed in point no. 5 below. The assessment sheet duly approved by Competent Authority has already been communicated to the Higher Educational Institution through UGC-DEB portal on 14.11.2023.

*"No Higher Educational Institution shall offer any Open and Distance Learning Programme and/or Online Programme and admit learners thereto unless it has been granted recognition by the Commission and admission shall not be made in anticipation of the recognition".*

8. In the event of any Higher Educational Institution found offering programmes in Open and Distance Learning and/or Online mode without recognition of the Commission or in violation to any of the provisions of these regulations and guidelines or orders made there under, the Commission shall take action(s) as per Regulations 7 of Part-II of University Grants Commission (Open and Distance Learning Programmes and Online Programmes) Regulations, 2020 and its amendments.



9. The application of the HEI for the academic year 2023-24, session beginning July - August, 2023 stands closed.

10. The decision of the Commission shall be final and binding on the Higher Educational Institution.

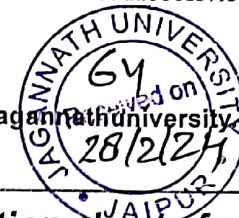

- The recognition period shall start from academic year academic year 2023-24, academic session beginning February, 2024 and onwards
- The Higher Educational Institution shall comply with all the provisions of the University Grants Commission (Open and Distance Learning Programmes and Online Programmes) Regulations, 2020 and its amendments while offering the programmes in OL mode.
- The last date for completion of the admission process to offer programmes in OL mode for academic session February, 2024 is **31st March, 2024**. Accordingly, HEIs shall upload the admission details on UGC DEB web portal by **15th April, 2024**.

### II. For not recognized programmes:

- As stipulated under Sub-Regulation 7 of Regulations 5 of the University Grants Commission (Open and Distance Learning Programmes and Online Programmes) Regulations, 2020:

*"No Higher Educational Institution shall offer any Open and Distance Learning Programme and/or Online Programme and admit learners thereto unless it has been granted recognition by the Commission and admission shall not be made in anticipation of the recognition".*

- The application of the HEI stands closed and the HEI needs to apply afresh as and when UGC invites application for recognition of ODL and/or Online programmes.

- The decision of the Commission shall be final and binding on the Higher Educational Institution.

- In the event of any Higher Educational Institution found offering programmes in Open and Distance Learning mode and/or Online mode without recognition of the Commission or in violation to any of the provisions of these regulations and guidelines or orders made there under, the Commission shall take punitive actions as per Regulations 7 of Part-II of

University Grants Commission (Open and Distance Learning Programmes and Online Programmes) Regulations, 2020.
