## Registration Process

- Scan the QR code given here.
- You will be redirected to a Registration Form.
- Fill all the details properly.
- Complete your Payment in the registration form.
- Last date of registration is **30<sup>th</sup> November 2024**.
- Registration confirmation will be sent via email. Only after receiving the confirmation email from the organizers, the registration process shall be deemed final.
- In no circumstance shall the registration fee be refunded.
- Hurry up limited slots only.



## Important Notes

- Teams must arrive at least 30 minutes before match time for check-in and warm-up.

- Only one Team will be allowed in each event from each Institute.

# JU FROLIC 24

## General Rules

- Teams must arrive at least 30 minutes before match time for check-in and warm-up.
- Every participant must bring their college or university student ID card for verification; no participant will be allowed to perform without it.
- Referee decisions shall be considered final.
- In case of any dispute, the organizers' decision shall be final.
- No food, transport, or accommodation facilities will be provided by the university.
- Registration confirmation will be sent by email. Without the confirmation email, the registration process is not considered complete.
- Participants will be assigned a volunteer for contact before the event.
- Any unacceptable behaviour may lead to disqualification by the organizers.

## Detailed Rules: Cricket

### 1. Cricket Match - Rules

#### 1.1 Team Registration and Match Duration:

- Number of teams: Maximum of 8 teams, boys' teams only.
- Registration Fee: ₹1,000 per team.
- Reporting Time: 9 AM.
- Match Duration:
  - Qualifying Matches: 8 overs per side.
  - Semi Final Matches: 10 overs per side.
  - Final Match: 12 overs per side.
- Time Limit: Teams must complete their innings within 50 minutes; delays will incur penalties.
- Break: 10-minute break between innings.

#### 1.2 Teams and Participants:

- Players: A maximum of 11 players per team.
- Substitutes: 2 substitutes allowed for fielding, but substitutes cannot bat, bowl, or keep wickets.
- Only registered players on the form are allowed to participate.

#### 1.3 Equipment:

- Cricket balls will be provided by the organizers.
- Teams must bring their own cricket gear (bats, pads, gloves, etc.).

#### 1.4 Match Rules:

- Bowling Restrictions: Each bowler can bowl a maximum of 2 overs.
- Fielding Restrictions:
  - Power Play: A maximum of 2 fielders can be outside the 30-yard circle during the first 2 overs.
  - Post-Power Play: A maximum of 5 fielders outside the 30-yard circle.
- No Ball/Wide Ball: Standard cricket rules apply; a no-ball results in a free hit.
- Dismissals: Standard cricket dismissal methods apply (bowled, caught, LBW, stumped, run-out).

#### 1.5 Substitutions and Injuries:

- Fielding players can be substituted due to injury, but substitutes cannot bat, bowl, or keep wickets.
- Injured or dismissed players cannot return to bat unless allowed by the umpire.

#### 1.6 Code of Conduct:

- Players must exhibit sportsmanship, respect for opponents, and uphold the integrity of the game.
- The umpire's decision is final. Disputes will be resolved at the discretion of the umpires, and unsporting behavior may lead to penalties or disqualification.

#### 1.7 Winning Criteria:

- The team with the highest score wins.
- In the case of a tie, a Super Over will decide the winner.

#### 1.8 Awards and Prizes:

- Winner: Trophy + Cash Prize of ₹11,000.
- Runner-Up: Trophy + Cash Prize of ₹5,100.
- All team members will receive certificates.

## Volleyball Tournament – Rules

### 2.1 Team Registration and Match Duration:

- Number of teams: 10 teams each for Boys and Girls.
- Registration Fee: ₹500 per team.
- Reporting Time: 9 AM.
- Match Format: Best of 3 sets.
- Set Points: Each set to 15 points, must win by a 2-point lead.

### 2.2 Teams and Participants:

- Players: 6 players per team on the court.
- Substitutes: Up to 3 substitutes per team.
- Rotation: Managed by the team.

### 2.3 Equipment:

- Volleyballs will be provided by the organizers.
- Teams must wear matching jerseys.
- Sports shoes appropriate for the surface are required.

### 2.4 Match Rules:

- Serving: Serve from behind the baseline, both overhand and underhand serves are allowed.
- Scoring: Rally scoring system.
- Time-Outs: 2 timeouts per set (30 seconds each).
- Rotation/Substitution: Substitutions are allowed when the ball is not in play, and substitutions must be approved by the referee.

### 2.5 Substitutions and Injuries:

- Injury substitutions are allowed without affecting the team's rotation.
- Injured players may return with the referee's approval.

### 2.6 Code of Conduct:

- Players must respect opponents, teammates, and officials.
- Referee decisions are final, and unsportsmanlike conduct may lead to penalties.

### 2.7 Winning Criteria:

- The team that wins 2 out of 3 sets is the match winner.
- Points are awarded as 2 points for a win, 0 for a loss.

### 2.8 Awards and Prizes:

- Winner (Boys & Girls): Trophy + Cash Prize of ₹5,100.
- Runner-Up (Boys & Girls): Trophy + Cash Prize of ₹3,100.
- All team members will receive medals and certificates.

## Kabaddi Match – Rules

### 3.1 Team Registration and Match Duration:

- Number of teams: 10 teams each for Boys and Girls.
- Registration Fee: ₹500 per team.
- Reporting Time: 9 AM.
- Match Duration: Two halves of 20 minutes with a 5-minute break.
- Timeouts: 2 timeouts per half (30 seconds each).

### 3.2 Teams and Participants:

- Players: 7 players per team, 3 substitutes.
- Captain: Each team must designate a captain for referee discussions.
- Substitutes can rotate in during stoppages, timeouts, or injuries.

### 3.3 Equipment:

- Matches will be held on a standard Kabaddi court.
- Teams must wear matching uniforms.
- Non-marking sports shoes are required.

### 3.4 Match Rules:

- Raiding: Raids must be completed within 30 seconds.
- Bonus Line: 1 bonus point for crossing the bonus line with 6 or more defenders.
- Out of Bounds: Raid is unsuccessful if any part of the raider's body crosses the boundary line.
- Tackling: Defenders may tackle raiders within the allowed physical limits.

### 3.5 Scoring:

- Successful Raid: 1 point for each tagged defender if the raider returns safely.
- Bonus Point: 1 point for crossing the bonus line with 6+ defenders.
- All Out: 2 points for clearing all defenders.

### 3.6 Revival and Substitution:

- Revival: A successful tag revives one player.
- Injury Substitutions: Allowed when the game is stopped.

### 3.7 Code of Conduct:

- Players must show sportsmanship and respect for officials.
- Referee decisions are final and binding.

### 3.8 Winning Criteria:

- The team with the most points at the end wins.
- In the case of a tie, a 5-minute golden raid period will be held. The first team to score wins.
- Points system: 2 points for a win, 1 for a tie, and 0 for a loss.

### 3.9 Awards and Prizes:

- Winner (Boys & Girls): Trophy + Cash Prize of ₹5,100.
- Runner-Up (Boys & Girls): Trophy + Cash Prize of ₹3,100.
- All team members will receive medals and certificates.

## Cultural Dance Competitions – Rules

### 4.1 Solo Folk Dance and Solo Western Dance:

- Time Limit: 3 to 4 minutes.
- Exceeding the time limit will lead to point deductions.
- Props and Costumes: Props must be managed by participants, and costumes must align with the theme.
- Music Submission: Submit MP3 format tracks before December 5th, properly labelled with participant name and category.
- Code of Conduct: Participants must avoid vulgar or inappropriate language and themes in their performances.
- Registration Fee: ₹200 per participant.

### 4.2 Group Folk Dance and Group Western Dance:

- Team Size: Minimum 4 participants, maximum 10.
- Time Limit: 3 to 5 minutes.
- Exceeding the time limit will lead to point deductions.
- Props and Costumes: Managed by participants, costumes should reflect the dance theme.
- Music Submission: Submit MP3 format tracks before December 5th.
- Code of Conduct: No use of inappropriate language, symbols, or actions.
- Registration Fee: ₹500 per team.

### 4.3 Judging Criteria:

- Solo and Group Performances: Judged on choreography, expression, creativity, synchronization (group performances), and adherence to the theme.

### 4.4 Disqualification:

- Inappropriate content, language, or behavior will result in immediate disqualification.

### 4.5 Awards and Prizes:

- Solo Folk and Solo Western Dance:
  - Winner: Trophy + Cash Prize of ₹2,100.
  - Runner-Up: Trophy + Cash Prize of ₹1,100.
- Group Folk and Group Western Dance:
  - Winner: Trophy + Cash Prize of ₹5,100.
  - Runner-Up: Trophy + Cash Prize of ₹3,100.
- All team members will receive certificates.
