Agenda Item No. 01: To confirm the minutes of the meeting of the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) held on April 10, 2017.

Resolution 01: The minutes of 4th Meeting of IQAC held on April 10, 2017 were read and confirmed.

Agenda Item No. 02: To consider the progress made on various issues by the respective departments in relation to IQAC.

Resolution 02: The current semester's activities and achievements of every Department were summarized and discussed, and views were exchanged by the Deans and other members for further improvement in the next session. The Vice Chancellor reminded and laid stress on boosting the morale of faculty members to engage more and more in research related activities.

The University has received the approval and grant from NSS for organizing NSS camps.

The University successfully organized the following:

- (a) ICDL Asia Foundation, that manages the leading international computer skills certification across Asia, hosted ICDL Asia Digital Challenge 2017, the first ever ICDL computer and digital skills competition in Asia. On May 3, 2017, and May 31, 2017, Faculty of Engineering and Technology successfully organized the two (out of total three) Qualifying Rounds in Jagan Nath University Campus in the presence of ICDL volunteers. A total of 61 students from the Faculty of Engineering and Technology, Faculty of Science, Faculty of Law and Faculty of Management enthusiastically participated in the contest.
- (b) Faculty of Science organized an NSS camp on June 3, 2017. The following activities were carried out in the camp:
 - a. Removal of weeds
 - b. Making thala around trees and preparing bunds on side of paths and plots
 - c. Cleaning of Campus
- (c) Free ENT Check-Up Camp was organized for the University employees and students on May 10, 2017.

Agenda Item No. 3: To discuss the steps taken for the commencement of new courses in the Faculty of Engineering & Technology and Faculty of Management.

Resolution 03: Keeping in view, the growing demands of industry, new courses have been proposed and introduced for the forth coming session. Under Faculty of Engineering & Technology and Faculty of Management, the following courses have been introduced:

- (a) B.Tech. in Mechatronics
- (b) B.Tech in Petroleum Engineering
- (c) B.Tech. in Computer Science and Engineering (With specialization in Cloud Computing & Virtualization Technology **(In academic collaboration with IBM)**)
- (d) B.Tech. in Computer Science and Engineering (With Specialization in Business Analytics and Optimization **(In academic collaboration with IBM)**)
- (e) B. Voc. in Software Development

- (f) B.Voc. in Hotel Management (**In academic collaboration with Dangayach School of Hotel Management – Marriott Group**)
- (g) B.Voc. in Retail Management
- (h) MBA in Business Analytics (**In academic collaboration with IBM**)
- (i) B. Com. In Corporate Management

Steps taken for preparation of appropriate ground for the implementation of the aforesaid courses were discussed among the IQAC members.
