2.	Evaluate elective offerings to better align with specialization streams and technological advancements.	Stakeholder input, including faculty and industry experts, was gathered to inform the evaluation process. Adjustments were made to elective courses to ensure relevance to specialization areas and emerging technologies.
3.	Ensure a consistent balance between theory and application across all courses.	A comprehensive review of course curriculum was conducted to ensure a consistent balance between theory and application. Course schedules were adjusted as needed to provide ample time for both theoretical learning and practical application.

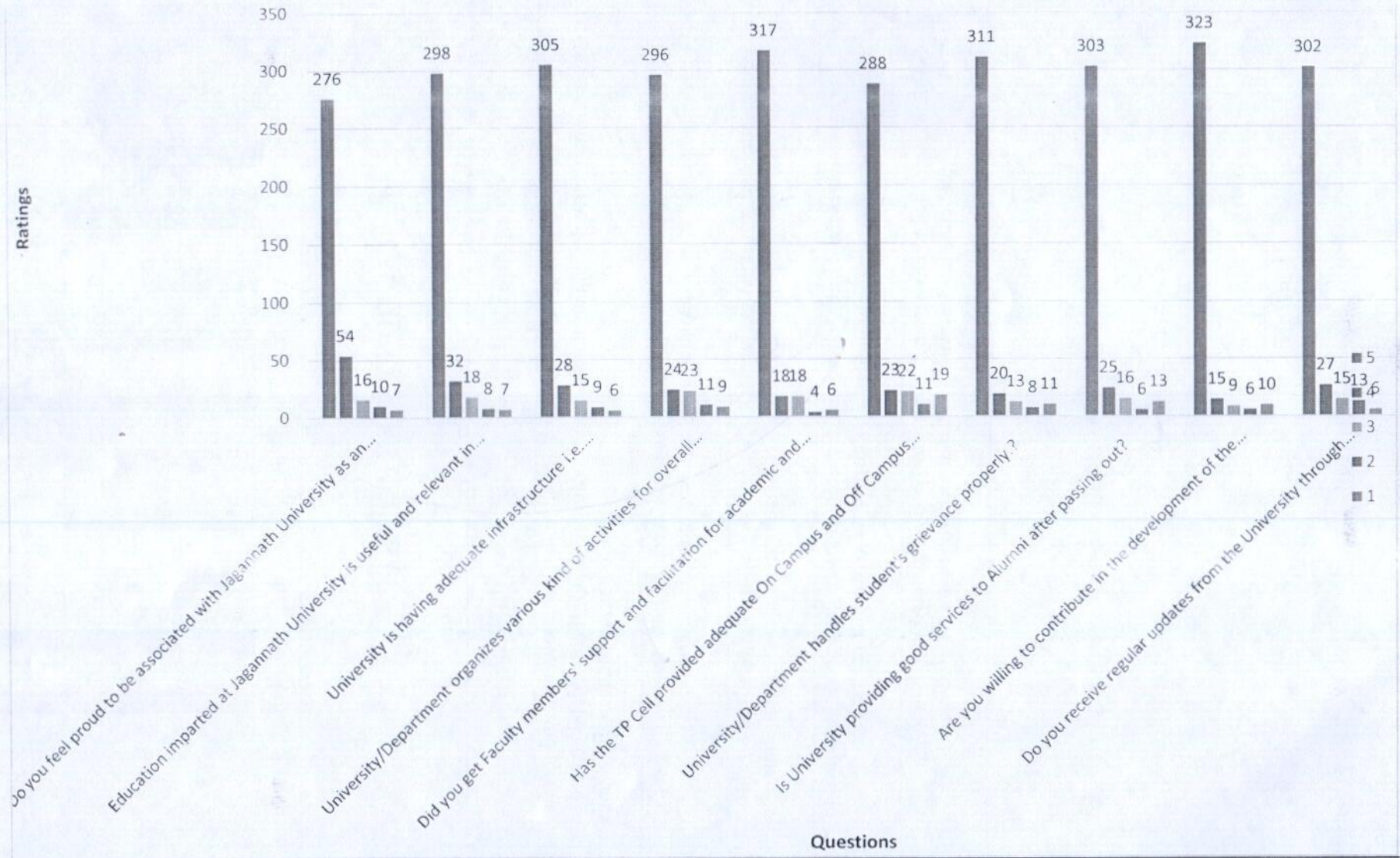
